SENIOR CITIZENS TUITION AND FEES WAIVER

NOTE: Students who wish to enroll in the college with free tuition under the Senior Citizens Act must wait until all students paying tuition have had an opportunity to enroll in that class before they can enroll. SENIOR CITIZENS are accepted on a space-available basis only.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for free tuition and fees for credit courses, part-time or full-time, a person must meet the following criteria:

- (1) Be 60 years of age or older.
- (2) Be a legal resident of Virginia
- (3) Had a taxable income not exceeding \$10,000 for Federal Income Tax purposes for the year in which enrollment is sought.

To be eligible for free tuition for **audit** of credit courses or for taking **non-credit** courses (not to exceed three courses per term), a person must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Be 60 years of age or older.
- 2) Be a legal resident of Virginia.
- 3) Be admitted to the College as a student.

NOTE: Auditing a course requires the approval of the appropriate division chair or director.
