

DCC Offers Financial Aid Application Support During 'FAFSA Simplification Act' Transition

The Federal Application for Student Aid (FAFSA), which traditionally opens in October each year, is experiencing a delay in its release for the 2024-25 academic year. This delay is attributed to the comprehensive overhaul brought about by the FAFSA Simplification Act, impacting the processes and systems used to award financial aid to college students nationwide. Danville Community College (DCC), in anticipation of this change, has planned workshops throughout January 2024 to support students who may need guidance or assistance with their financial aid application.

Beginning January 2, 2023, students may purchase books and supplies using their Pell Grant, scholarships or third party student financial aid. Charges will end on January 30, 2023.



DCC TARE Department Receives New Grant

The Virginia Department of Social Services has awarded Danville Community College's TARE Department a grant of \$250K to be used between January 2024 and June 2024 to assist students who have children and make less than 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines in obtaining short term workforce credentials. The TARE Department offers free workforce training and pays for tuition and supportive services for students who qualify. This new grant will allow our office to expand and increase supportive services to qualifying students said Paul Farrar Director of TARE programs at Danville Community College.

Also included in this grant is \$37,500 that will be awarded as a Subgrant from DCC's TARE Department to Patrick and Henry Community College to offer TARE Services in their service region as well. With this grant we truly have a regional effort to lift people of out poverty and put them on the path to living a self sustained life according to Paul Farrar. This will allow us to serve the most needy of our population over a large geographical area including the counties of Patrick, Henry, Pittsylvania, and Halifax along with the cities of Danville and Martinsville.

With all of the new job opportunities coming to this region, now is the time to get the skills needed to participate in our workforce. This grant can be renewed for \$500,000 a year for the next 3 years starting July 2024- July 2027 as long as funds remain. This is a substantial 1.7 million dollar investment in the quality education provided by DCC and P&HCC to our region.


Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society News


