eBooks on EBSCOhost is a collection of over 7,000 electronic books on a wide variety of topics which was formerly available through Netlibrary. This database can be accessed by selecting the link to **Magazines & Journals** (Full Text) on the e-Library page at <http://www.dcc.vccs.edu/lrc/E-Library/elibrary.htm> and finding the link to the database alphabetically in the list of databases, or by entering the following URL: <http://library.vccs.edu/license-bin/linker.plx?ebsconlebk>.



When you select the link to **EBook Full Text**, you will be taken to the page shown above. From this page you can read the book online, print, and email pages. **If you are printing an eBook, up to 60 pages of a title can be printed per user.** Hover the mouse over the icons displayed on the right side of the page under **Tools** to see other options, such as searching for words within the book, citing the book, and creating bookmarks and permalinks. Use the arrows in the blue banner at the bottom of the screen to go from one page to another, or type the number of the page you want to look at in the white box between the two arrows and select **Go**. The icons on the left side of the blue banner can be used to zoom in and out and to modify the display screen. Note the **Table of Contents** shown at the left side of the page. Select a link within the Table of Contents to go to that section of the book.

In order to download ebooks you must create an EBSCOhost account. Select the link to **Sign In** at the top of the page and then select **Create a new Account**. You can either **Sign In** before starting to search on the database, or you will be prompted to enter your **EBSCOhost** User Name and password when you select the link to download a title.

In order to download and read eBooks offline, you must install Adobe Digital Editions (version 1.7.1 or higher) on your computer. This free software can be downloaded from <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions>. A maximum of 10 eBooks can be checked out for download per person.

To download an eBook:

1. Click the **Download (Offline)** link for the eBook you would like to download.
2. Select a **Checkout period** from the drop-down menu and click the **Checkout & Download** button. (Note: If you are not logged into your My **Ebscohost** account, you will be prompted to do so).
3. Select **Open with** or **Save File** from the resulting dialog box. (Note: If you select **Open with**, your eBook will be opened with Adobe Digital Editions. If you select **Save file**, the eBook will be saved to your computer and can be opened with Adobe Digital Editions at a later time)
4. After you check out and download your eBook you may choose to transfer your eBook to your Adobe Digital Editions-compatible eBook Reader device, such as Barnes & Noble Nook, Sony Daily Edition, iPad, or Sony Digital Readers. A complete list of these devices can be found by going to <http://support.ebsco.com/ebooks> and selecting the link to **Supported Devices** under **eBook Resources**.
5. You can re-download the eBook from your **MyEbscohost** folder at any time during your checkout period. You will find the eBook in your **Checkout** folder at the left side of the screen, as displayed below. **Note that the Checkout folder also indicates the time remaining on your checkout.**
