

HEERF Distribution Report

Danville Community College (DCC) received \$802,111.00 from the Department of Education to provide Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) to students. DCC has up to a year to distribute these funds.

The total amount of HEERF monies distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of May 26, 2020 was \$766,800.00.

A total of 852 students received the initial disbursement of the CARES Act.

Students were awarded based on the following eligibility requirements:

- Have a completed 2019-2020 FAFSA on file at DCC;
- Meet all TIV eligibility requirements;
- Be enrolled in a Financial Aid eligible degree or certificate program (16 or more total credits);
- Be enrolled in at least one on-campus course as of March 13, 2020;
- Be enrolled half-time (6 or more credits);
- Have a verified EFC of 20,000 or below.

Students awarded received a message relating to the award, a comment was put in SIS, and a positive service indicator was placed on their account to easily identify the award and assist with reporting purposes.

The remaining amount of \$35,311.00 is available for students *who were not awarded in the initial round of disbursements*, to request emergency funds. Funds will be awarded based on the eligibility requirements listed above, with one exception. Students with a verified EFC greater than 20,000 will be awarded \$500.00.

*As of July 30, 2020, DCC has received 14 applications for the additional emergency relief funds. Of those 14 students, only 2 students met the eligibility requirements. Students were not awarded due to receiving the initial award of \$900.00, not being half-time during the Spring 2020 semester, or not being enrolled in at least one on-campus course as of March 13, 2020.

*As of September 9, 2020, DCC has received 28 applications for the emergency relief funds. Of those 28 applications, (one submission was a duplicate application), 5 students meet the eligibility requirements and have been approved for an award. This is a total of \$2,900.00 that has been awarded to date.

*As of October 31, 2020, DCC has received 34 applications for the emergency relief funds. Of those 34 application, (one submission was a duplicate application), 5 students meet the eligibility requirements and have been approved for an award. This is a total of \$2,900.00 that

has been awarded to date. Students were not awarded due to receiving the initial award of \$900.00, not being half-time during the Spring 2020 semester, or not being enrolled in at least one on-campus course as of March 13, 2020.

Students not eligible are sent a message and an email notifying them that they are not eligible for the HEERF award, however, informing them that if they have a documented financial emergency as a result of COVID-19 they can reach out to the Educational Foundation for possible assistance.

*On November 11, 2020, \$32,411.00 remains. A second disbursement went out to students, using the same criteria as the initial batch in May, with the exception of limiting the disbursement to PELL eligible students (EFC less than 5712) enrolled for the Fall 2020 semester. This identified 313 students that received \$100.00 each, for a total of \$31,300.00.

*As of January 4, 2021, DCC has received 40 applications for the emergency relief funds. Of those 40 application, (one submission was a duplicate application), 5 students meet the eligibility requirements and have been approved for an award.

The remaining balance in the HEERF funds is \$1,111.00.
