## SENIOR CITIZENS TUITION AND FEES WAIVER

NOTE: Students who wish to enroll in the college with free tuition under the Senior Citizens Act must wait until all students paying tuition have had an opportunity to enroll I that class before they can enroll. SENIOR CITIZENS are accepted on a space-available basis only.

## Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for free tuition and fees for credit courses, part-time or full-time, a person must meet the following criteria:

- (1) Be 60 years of age or older.
- (2) Be a legal resident of Virginia
- (3) Had a taxable income not exceeding \$10,000 for Federal Income Tax purposes for the year in which enrollment is sought.

To be eligible for free tuition for <u>audit</u> of credit courses or for taking <u>non-credit</u> courses (not to exceed three courses per term), a person must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Be 60 years of age or older.
- 2) Be a legal resident of Virginia.
- 3) Be admitted to the College as a student.
- NOTE: Auditing a course requires the approval of the appropriate division chair or director.
